NOVEMBER IN CAGLIARI

Cagliari, the capital and the most populous city of the Italian island of Sardinia, will host this year's editions of the International Conference on Cognition and Exploratory Learning in Digital Age (CELDA 2019), the International Conference WWW/Internet (ICWI 2019) and the International Conference on Applied Computing (AC 2019). The conferences will take place from the 7th to the 9th November 2019.

The Applied Computing 2019 conference aims to address the main issues of concern within the applied computing area and related fields. This conference covers essentially technical aspects. The applied computing field is divided into more detailed areas. The proceedings of the conference will be published in the form of a book and digital copy with ISBN.

The CELDA 2019 conference aims to address the main issues concerned with evolving learning processes and supporting pedagogies and applications in the digital age. There have been advances in both cognitive psychology and computing that have affected the educational arena. The convergence of these two disciplines is increasing at a fast pace and affecting academia and professional practice in many ways.

The WWW/Internet 2019 Conference aims to address the main issues of concern within WWW/Internet. WWW and Internet had a huge development in recent years. Aspects of concern are no longer just technical anymore but other aspects have arisen. This conference aims to cover both technological as well as non-technological issues related to these developments.

The official language of these conference is English and all conferences are blind peer-reviewed.
